

## Foundation Adrian and Simone Frutiger scientific prize

The Foundation Adrian and Simone Frutiger, a non-profit institution of public interest, was created in Bremgarten on November 15th, 2006, by Adrian and Simone Frutiger. The Foundation awards an annual scientific prize of CHF 20'000.

This prize is awarded following the proposal of the Scientific Committee appointed by the Foundation Council. It is intended to recognize post-doctoral research work (research paper or a series of related publications) performed in Switzerland, which makes an important contribution or innovation at the international level in the field of neuropsychiatry and neuropsychology, particularly related to young people.

### Conditions

Applicants must be under 44 years of age at the time of application. The research work may not be submitted for other awards at the same time. For application, the following documents must be submitted by the end of march of each current year in electronic form to the chair of the Scientific Committee (see below):

- A letter of support for the application, written by a professor of a Swiss University; this letter will have to underline the research qualities of the candidate, indicating in particular the candidate's potential to develop and to coordinate high-level research.

- The concise summary of the research constituting the application (maximum 1000 words)
- Copies of the respective paper(s)
- A concise CV including a summary of research interests and h-factor (ISI).
- A publication list of peer-reviewed papers, grouped into original and other publications.
